The Board of Commissioners of Candler County held a work session on Monday, October 2, 2017, at 5:00 p.m., in the Commissioners' boardroom at 1075 East Hiawatha Street, Suite A, Metter, Georgia. Chairman Thrift called the work session to order at 5:03 p.m.

Mel Kelly-EMS Report

Candler County EMS Director, Melburn Kelly, presented the Candler County EMS September 2017 Report. (See Exhibit A)

Mike Robins – Recreation Department Monthly Report

Coach Mike Robins, Candler County Recreation Department Director, approached the Board to deliver his monthly report. Fall sports begin October 3, 2017. Soccer registrations are up, and football registrations are down. He spoke of the minimal damage from Hurricane Irma. The new score board is scheduled to arrive in two weeks.

Jerry Lanier - Roads and Bridges Department Monthly Report

Candler County Public Works Road Superintendent, Jerry Lanier approached the Board to deliver his monthly report. Mr. Lanier reported about 75% of the debris and damage had been cleared from Hurricane Irma within the County and planned to clear the Recreation Department next. He reported one of the flashing solar panel lights had been stolen on the South side of Cannoochee Road. He reported three pick-up trucks with transmission problems and a dump truck that needs repairing.

Robert Hendrix - Solid Waste/Landfill Report

Candler County Landfill Director, Robert Hendrix approached the Board to deliver his monthly report. Mr. Hendrix passed out the current and prior year capacity reports. The two wells have been installed. They have been inspected, and Mr. Hendrix is awaiting a report from Robert Hillar. There was some discussion of a request from a local company to place solar panels out in the landfill. Allgreen purchased a new trash truck. Mr. Eaves asked for Mr. Hendricks to have Becky Loveall to produce a three month

report about raw tonnage. Mr. Hendrix concluded with a report of the Adult Education Center's ceiling repairs.

Jason Douglas Fire Department and EMA Monthly Report

Candler County EMA Director and City of Metter Fire Chief, Jason Douglas approached the Board to deliver his monthly fire response report. Chief Douglas delivered the monthly fire report for September and updated the Board on EMA. Two FEMA reimbursement checks are yet to be received for Hurricane Matthew. Mr. Eaves asked about the grinding of the debris piles that belong to the County and City. Chief Douglas stated the contractor is less expensive to grind both piles at once.
