**Mel Kelly-EMS Report**

Candler County EMS Director, Melburn Kelly, presented his monthly transport report for June 2019. (Exhibit A)

- Revenues down for June 2019. No bad debt collection.
- Noticed CCH had an increased call volume outsourcing to private ambulance as of June 1.
- Two potential part-time employees that Mr. Aasheim will present
- Spoke about the state wide D.A.R.T. Program

**Mike Robins – Recreation Department Monthly Report**

Candler County Recreation Department Director, Mike Robins approached the Board to deliver his June 2019 monthly report.

- Baseball and softball seasons have ended. Five All Star teams were established. The 8U Baseball team and the 10U Baseball both went on to district championship games.
- \$4,600.00 cleared for the tournament hosted by Candler County Recreation Department.
- The 8U Baseball team and the 10U Baseball both went to the state championship. The 10U Baseball team placed 3<sup>rd</sup> at the state playoffs in Appling County. The 8U Baseball team made the winners bracket, but did not place.
- Soccer and basketball registration will begin August 5<sup>th</sup>.
- Half day rentals are requested for the Jack Strickland Building. However, Coach Robins stated he is not in favor of it. Also something to consider, no police presence for parties that end before dark.
- Consider the Weight Room to be remodeled and utilized for the use of a Birthday House. Coach Robins stated that 4H BB team uses the room now for practice, but it is currently not a revenue source.

**Jerry Lanier – Roads and Bridges Department Monthly Report**

Candler County Public Works Road Superintendent, Jerry Lanier approached the Board to deliver his monthly report.

- Stated he and his staff are maintaining the roads during the drought.

**Robert Hendrix – Candler County Landfill Monthly Report**

Candler County Solid Waste and Recycling Center Supervisor, Robert Hendrix, approached the Board to deliver his monthly report.

- Expressed his appreciation for everyone who helped with the landfill responsibilities during his medical absence. Still doing therapy, but working as the doctor prescribed.
- He reported on the permit, and that Mr. Aasheim has been working on a possible less expensive permit with Robert Hillar for 2020.
- Maintenance repairs were made to the pump at the landfill and the invoice has been submitted.
- Capacity report should be received soon. The flyover has been performed.
- He concluded with thanking Vice-Chairman Jones for the emergency assist. Vic-Chairman Jones stated that there will be no invoiced associated with the repairs.

**Allen Tyler - Coroner**

Candler County Coroner, Allen Tyler approached the Board to give the June monthly report.

**Jerry and Brenda Ann Odom – Hear a Request for a Mobile Home Variance**
