The Board of Commissioners of Candler County met for a called meeting on Monday, January 27, 2020, at 5:00 p.m., in the Commissioners' boardroom at 1075 East Hiawatha Street, Suite A, Metter, Georgia. Those attending the meeting were Candler County Chairman, Glyn Thrift; Candler County Vice-Chairman, Brad Jones; Commissioners David Robinson, Blake Hendrix and Wayne Culbertson; Candler County Administrator, Bryan Aasheim; Candler County Attorney, Kendall Gross; Candler County Clerk, Maranda K. Lank. Guest included Chris Hunter, Chris Valentin, Victor Drowdy, Jeff Smith, Theresa Gay, Timothy Wood, Christian Reynolds, Stacey Anderson Tapley, Melissa Knight, and Sheriff John Miles. Jerri Goodman attended this meeting on behalf of the Metter Advertiser.

Call to Order

Chairman Thrift called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance

Commissioner Robinson delivered the invocation. Chairman Thrift led the *Pledge of Allegiance*.

Approval of the Agenda

Vice-Chairman Jones moved to amend and approve the agenda to change the order of items 4 and 5 to read as follows:

Mr. Aasheim presented the change and requested the Commissioners to approve a request to increase the 2011 SPLOST appropriations for the Windows 10 upgrade project by \$430.29 to \$22,430.29 to complete the project. Consideration of proposals submitted in response of an RFP for Emergency Ambulance Services for Candler County

Mr. Aasheim presented the names of the companies that submitted an RFP. Chris Hunter and Chris Valentino approached the Commission to explain the RFP submitted by AMR and requested clarification on some penalties.

Mr. Aasheim opened and presented the bids in the order as follows:

- Excelsior Ambulance Service - \$375,000 per year
- Grady EMS - \$650,000
- Goldcross EMS - \$500,000
- AMR - \$672,000 (1 ALS and 1 BLS) Noted this could be determined on County Assets

Mr. Aasheim proposed preparing a summary package for the Commissioners before taking action. Chairman Thrift requested that Mr. Aasheim and Mr. Gross prepare the summary package. Vice-Chairman Jones made a motion seconded by Commissioner Culbertson for Mr. Aasheim and Mr. Gross to prepare a summary package. The motion carried 5-0.
