

**Board of Commissioners of Candler County**  
**Called Meeting**  
**May 4, 2017**

The Board of Commissioners of Candler County held a called meeting on Thursday, May 4, 2017, at 5:00 p.m., in the Commissioners' boardroom at 1075 East Hiawatha Street, Suite A, Metter, Georgia. The purpose of the called meeting was to discuss road closure and any other business that may be brought before the Board. Those attending the meeting were Candler County Commission Chairman Thrift, Candler County Vice-Chairman Brad Jones and Commissioners Donny Wells, David Robinson and Wayne Culbertson; Candler County Clerk, Maranda K. Lank; and Candler County Attorney, Kendall Gross; The Metter Advertiser representative, Jerri Goodman was present. Other guests included Wesley Parker of Parker Engineering, Marty Franklin, Ty Tyson, and Jimmy Brady. Candler County Administrator, Doug Eaves was unable to attend the Called meeting.

**Call To Order**

Vice-Chairman Jones called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m.

**Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance**

Vice-Chairman Jones delivered the invocation followed by Chairman Thrift leading the *Pledge of Allegiance*.

**SDS Plan**

Mr. Gross explained the City of Metter's position to participate in the SPLOST meeting. Vice-Chairman Jones gave a detailed report of the Shared Services meeting held Wednesday, May 2, 2017. Those Candler County representatives attending that meeting included Chairman Thrift, Vice-Chairman Jones, County Administrator Eaves and County Attorney Kendall Gross. No quorum was present and no minutes recorded during the meeting.

**Revisit Jones Road**

Chairman Thrift announced Allen Strange withdrew the proposed bid accepted by the Board to repair Jones Road.

Chairman Thrift made a motion seconded by Commissioner Robinson to accept the withdrawal of the bid submitted by Allen Strange that the Board accepted and took action on during the Monday, May 1, 2017 Regular meeting to repair Jones Road for \$12,000.00. The motion passed unanimously.

Wesley Parker presented and explained the plans recommended by Parker Engineering to properly repair Jones Road.

The item was tabled until further information could be gathered.
