

**Board of Commissioners of Candler County
Called Meeting
October 26, 2017
10:00 A.M.**

The Board of Commissioners of Candler County held a called meeting on Thursday, October 26, 2017, at 10:00 a.m., in the Commissioners' boardroom at 1075 East Hiawatha Street, Suite A, Metter, Georgia. The purpose of the called meeting was to ratify the Candler County School Board millage rate to set the 2017 Tax Digest. Call to Order

2017 Tax Digest and Millage Rate for Candler County Board of Education

Vice-Chairman Jones made the motion seconded by Commissioner Wells to adopt the Resolution to Ratify the Candler County School Board Ad Valorem tax levy for 2017. The motion passed unanimously.
