STATE OF GEORGIA CANDLER COUNTY

WHEREAS, Candler County, Georgia will experience an event of critical significance as a result of Winter Weather;

WHEREAS, the Governor has declared a state of emergency for Candler County, Georgia;

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Chairman of the Candler County Board of Commissioners, with advice from the Director of Emergency Management Agency for Candler County, Georgia, there exists emergency circumstances that require extraordinary actions for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Candler County, including individuals with household pets and service animals; and

WHEREAS, based on said debriefing, it appears necessary and proper for certain measures to be taken to protect, prevent or minimize injury to people and damage to property resulting from this event, certain actions are required.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested by local and state law; IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that a local state of emergency exists and shall continue until the conditions requiring this declaration are abated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the County Administrator is authorized to suspend the county's purchasing policies, requirements, and restrictions as needed to provide for the health and safety of the citizens of Candler County.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that the Candler County Emergency Management Agency activate the Emergency Operations Plan.
