Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance


Commissioner Wells delivered the invocation followed by Chairman Thrift leading the *Pledge of Allegiance*.

The Board interviewed Mr. Aasheim on Monday due to a scheduled out of town meeting that Mr. Aasheim had previously committed himself to for his current employer.


Adjournment
